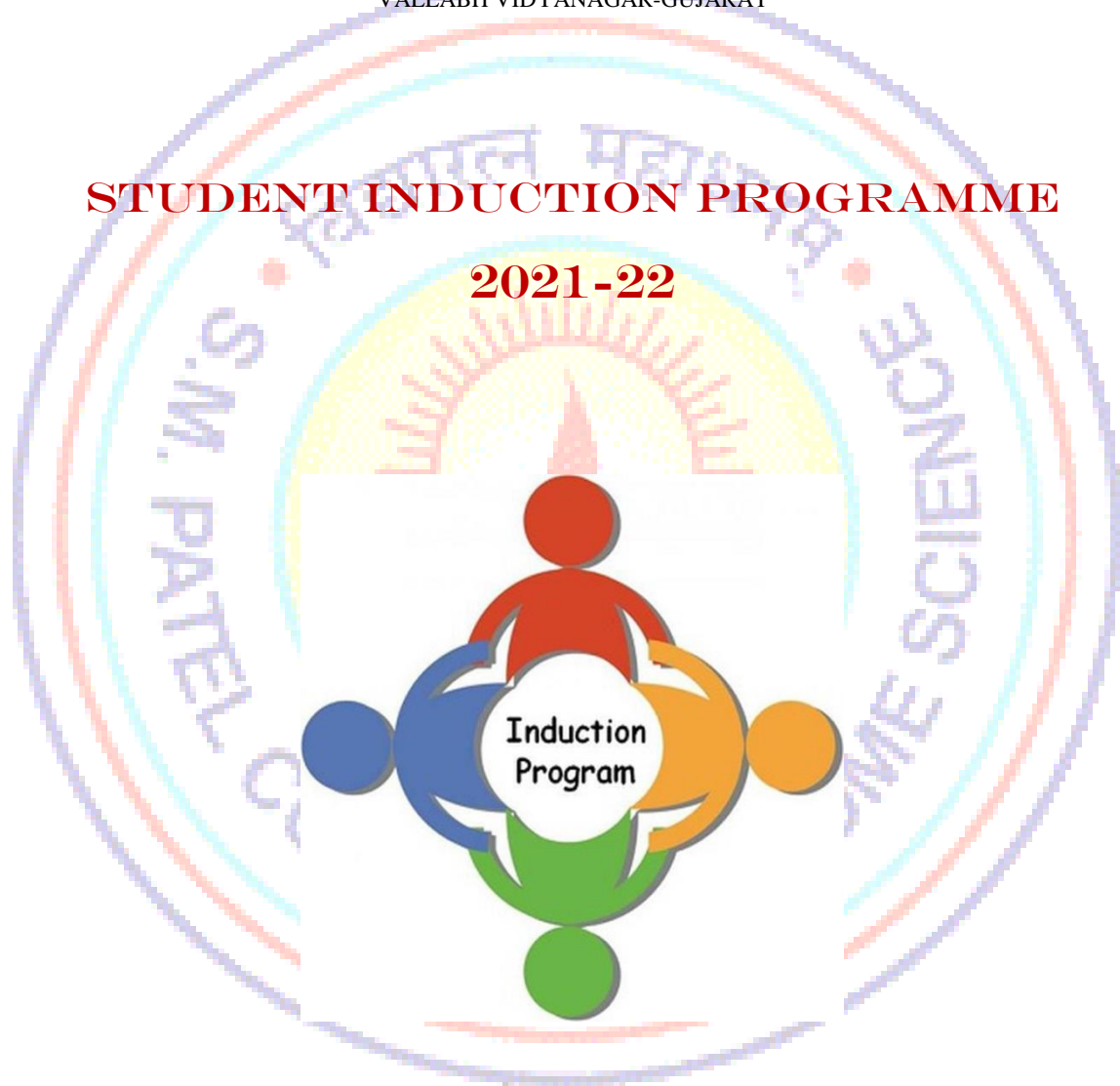

INTRODUCTION:
