PART B:

1. ACTIVITIES REFLECTING THE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE INSTITUTION:

Home science is a scientific course of study which molds a student with variety of life skills. This is a unique discipline with a blend of science and art. Home science as a field of study is application oriented and prepares students for many professions. It includes professional training for skills in wide spectrum of jobs. The students are trained to acquire analytical mind, have scientific acumen, practical and rational approach towards life situation and develop aesthetic and creative sense.

The scientific background and structural approach distinguish them as specialist

The college offers specialization in the areas of:

- Foods and Nutrition
- Human Development
- Family Resource Management
- Textile and Clothing
- A vocational degree in Food science and Quality Control is offered on self-finance basis.

- The college has IGNOU Study center for M.Sc. programme in dietetics and Food service management.
- College has also introduced Add-on-Courses in
 - Sports Nutrition
 - Fashion design
 - Interiors

- Study tours are organized for students with a aim to provide firsthand experience in the area of specialization and to enhance their outlook in general.
- Each department has organized workshop to enhance skills of the students and to stimulate creativity in their respective field.
- Each department organizes parent –teacher interactive meet once in a year. The parents are given information on higher studies, where it can be done and they are motivated to allow their wards to pursue higher education. Throughout the year the counselor if needed involve parents in students problems on individual basis under the guidance of the Principal.
- Guest faculty are invited in specialized fields to upgrade knowledge in students.
- The library is well equipped with books, journals and magazine and inflibnet is installed. A well ventilated reading room is available for students. We have an open access system. T.Y. Students are given WIFI Facilities.

VARIOUS ACTIVITIES FOR THE OVERALL DEVELOPMENT OF THE STUDENTS UNDER SAPTDHARA:

➤ **Geet Sangeet Nritya Dhara:**

The dhara has organized interclass song and dance competition. The students participated in youth festival organized by group of progressive colleges here our college secured second prize in classical dance.

➤ **Gyan Dhara:**

An interactive talk on **stress management** focusing on concentration, confidence, attitude and time management was organized. The students learned about emotional garbage and ways to clean it .A lecture on women through decades was organized for all students. For the first year students Art of living programme was organized. The dhara also organized poetry compilation for students. A speech on ‘garbh sanskar’ was organized for T.Y. Students.

➤ **Kala Kaushalya Dhara:**

To exhibit creativity of the students college organizes various activities like poster making, card making, rakhi making etc. A workshop on basic handicraft course ‘O’ level was organized and students competed in youth festival organized by group of progressive colleges.

➤ **Vyayam yog khelkhood Dhara:**

The college hosted inter-college chess (men/women) tournament organized by group of progressive college in which 20 teams participated. Interclass chess, carom, Table Tennis, badminton, and kabaddi were organized. The college secured first position in basketball and kabaddi and athletics 800 meters, and third position in 4X100 meters relay in inter collegiate sports meet organized by group of progressive colleges. The college secured third position in football in khel maha khumbh organized by government of Gujarat and participated in athletics, badminton, chess and table tennis. The 44th annual sports day was organized where students participated in various games.

➤ **Natya Dhara:**

The students were shown CD’s for skit “mobile phone’ and mime “Nagdaman”.A skit competition on child’s right was organized. Students took part in skit, mime, monoacting and mimicry in youth festival organized by group of progressive colleges.

➤ **Sarjanaymak Abhivyakti Dhara:**

Students are motivated to participate in various competitions like poem, essay, poster, debate etc. organized by other institutions. Interclass elocution competition was organized. An intercollege debate competition was organized on topic “The virtual world is making us in different and insensitive to real world”. And the our college secured first prize on individual basis. Students participated in debate and extempore in youth festival organized by group of progressive colleges.

➤ **Samudayik Seva Dhara:**

This dhara focuses on inculcating social responsibilities towards community and sensitizing students towards the problems of community. Various programme were planned under NSS like thalassemia checkup camp, blood donation camp. Poster competition on AIDS, Rangoli competition, cleaning camps on swatch bharat. Students participated in Jan Dhan Yojna. They also participated in NSS mega camp at Ladnoo, Rajasthan organized by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. Students also attended adventure camp at Dhramshala. Annual NSS camp was organized at Devrajpura where various activities were conducted with involvement of villagers.

Under NCC ,students attended various camps in Gujarat and also attended national integration camp at Uttrakhand, Hyderabad, Bihar and Orissa.

2. NEW ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES INITIATED (U.G. &P.G.)

All three add-on-courses as per the instruction of Sardar Patel University from June 2014 are run by the college management, all the exams are conducted by the college including giving mark sheets and certificates.

These courses are offered to the students who have enrolled in UG courses. The students select an add-on-course of their choice so that along with their degree they get additional certificate & diploma.

Short term certificate course implemental- Flower arrangement creative art.

3. INNOVATIONS IN CIRRICULAR DESIGN AND TRANSACTION :

Continuing with the CBCS scheme at undergraduate programme the college offers courses as foundation, elective and core courses.

- Introduction of workshops at all levels to make the subjects more skill based.
- Extension activities are carried out to develop capacity building and , inculcate social service in students. In the internship course students work with Aganwadies adopted by the college and evaluated on the work done.
- In the subject Seminar small scale research project is given to the students to inculcate research culture in undergraduate students.

4. INTERDISCIPLINARY PROGRAMMES:

- Students from all the departments under the CBCS scheme can elect an elective subject offered by the department being interdisciplinary by nature.
- The add-on-courses are interdisciplinary and can be offered to any student at the U.G.Level.
- The M.Sc. (DFSM) course run by the IGNOU has students from the field of medicine, physiotherapy, sciences etc.

5. EXAMINATION REFORMS IMPLEMENTED:

- ❖ The college continues to follow the reforms made by the Sardar Patel University
- ❖ Students can avail 30 credits per semester including 24 credits for regular paper.

- ❖ Weightage of internal evaluation per subject is 40% and external is 60% for regular undergraduate course and add-on-courses.
- ❖ In internal assessment students will have to score 25% marks in individual subject and aggregate 35% score.
- ❖ In external assessment the student will have to score 40% in each course and 40% marks in aggregate of internal and external for particular course both in undergraduate and add-on- courses.
- ❖ Internal assessment is based on continuous and comprehensive assessment such as written test, quiz, seminar, projects, field trips, discussion laboratory work etc.
- ❖ Set question paper style is followed where questions paper contains multiple choice questions, short questions, long questions, very long questions.
- ❖ Ten point grading and class system was introduced based on CGPA instead of percentage in external university examination.
