### *Old Age Home Visit*

On date **1<sup>st</sup> Oct. 2016**, we visit the old age home at Karmsad which is at near Sai Temple, Karmsad, Anand. This old age home established on 11<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2006. It was started by “Shree Suryakant Patel” head of the trust. According to GroupWise, we were separate in different rooms. We met old people. They provide many facilities to them such as drinking water, bed, bed sheets, blanket, and western toilet-washroom attached, dining hall, snacks (like milk, fruit ect.)

Daily news-paper, book, music system and T.V. etc. they paid Rs. 3500/- per month. It was a free of one person. We met Vimalaben and Shantilalbha, they were from Nadiyad. Vimlaben has alive only by drinking milk everyday from last 16 years and Shantilalbhai suffering from paralysis in left hand and there both knees are not working so he can't walk properly. So they have some problem to take care.

Positively we feel much better often visiting their old age home. By talking with them, they both also feel better and happy. We also distributed fruits and sweets to them. Then returned to our college.



## Consumer Week

The FRM Department of the college celebrates Consumer week from 24<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> December. Exhibitions related to consumer awareness are arranged in FRM department of S.M. Patel College of Home Science for the benefit of the college students. ## Workshops

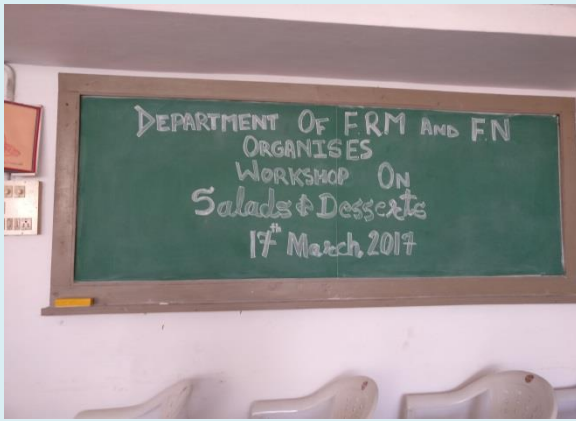
