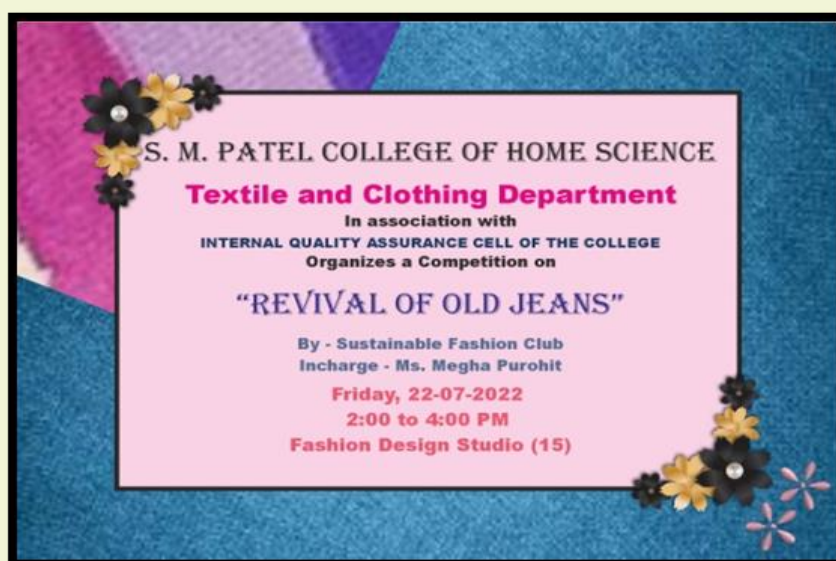

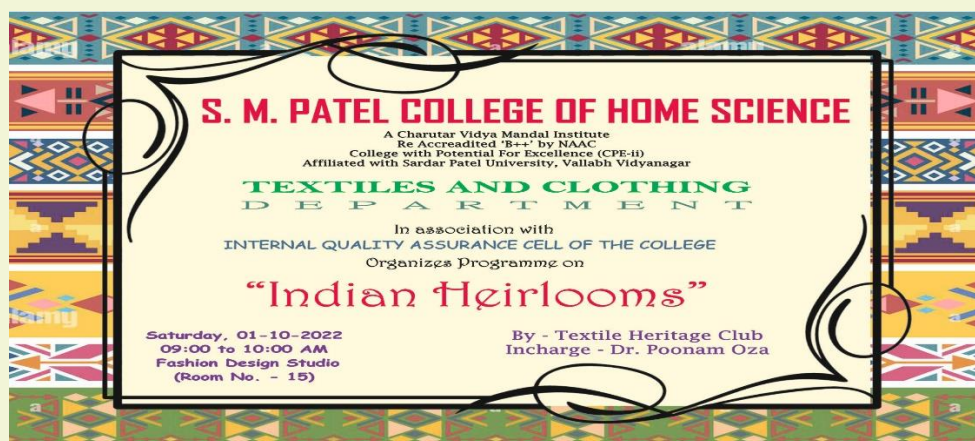
2. Workshop on “ Product Development with Tie and Dye”:

The expert was Dr. Poonam Oza and Ms. Megha Purohit, faculties of Textiles and Clothing Department. In this Workshop 31 school students were learn about different types of Tie and Dye technique and its implications in Household Textiles. Students were also emphasized on cutting and stitching of dyed product. Principal Dr. Bhavna Chauhan started with a rousing address to the students. Students were enjoyed and shared their positive response among this initiative of department.



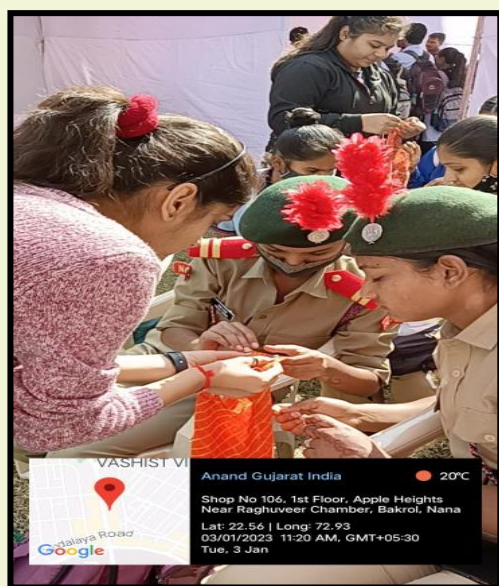
3. Programme on Indian Heirlooms:

A program on Indian Heirlooms was organized by the textile and clothing department of the S.M. Patel College of Home Science under the aegis of the Textile Heritage Club. The students of TY TC worked on Indian handloom under the course of subject specialists Dr. Poonam Oza and Megha Purohit. Different Handloom sarees from different Indian states were draped. The students displayed exquisite handwoven sarees that are representative of different Indian states, including Chanderi, Maheswari, Patola from Gujarat, Paithani from Maharashtra, Gharchola, Banarasi silk, and Rajasthani Kota Driya. The students were encouraged by Bhavana Chauhan. Dr. Minal Chauhan, the president of the college's student council, and other staff members attended the program.



4. Workshop on “Measures to reduce single use plastic”:

C.C. Patel community Science Centre, Sardar Patel University organised “Community Science Carnival-2023” from 02/01/2023 to 05/01/2023. Faculty and students in this Textiles and Clothing department train 4 Gujarat Girls Battalion, NCC Cadets from different Anand institutions. Cadets learned how to make a cloth bag out of an old saree using hand stitching. Because the usage of plastic has increased in recent years, this workshop was organised to raise awareness of sustainable alternatives for carrying daily necessities.



5. Activity on Tie and Dye with Traditional Embroidery on T-shirt:

On November 27, 2022, students in the Textiles and Clothing department's second and third years took part in a T-shirt tie-dye with embroidery activity. Students had received knowledge that white t-shirts that had been tie-dyed using various techniques and in a variety of colour combinations. They can generate income from this activity in the future.



6. Vocational Teacher Training for Trainers in Schools:

Textiles and Clothing Department with the collaboration of DIET, vocational teacher training was organized for the school districts of Anand's apparel made ups home furnishings trade trainers. Dr. Poonam Oza and Ms. Megha Purohit gave the trainers advice on how to learn the subject effectively for the previously mentioned trade. Trainers were also informed about the best ways to teach various sewing techniques, sewing machine specifics, etc.



7. Expert talk on Importance of Traditional Embroideries:

Students from Government primary and secondary school, Sihol Anand were learned about the use of traditional embroidery in clothing. Textiles and Clothing Department faculty and students orient and give school students practical exercise with basic embroidery stitches. The NSS of S. M. Patel College of Home Science organised this discussion and session. School students learnt a variety of interesting basic hand embroidery stitches.



8. Demonstration of surface ornamentation Technique in Agas village Anand under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan:

In Agas village, Anand, the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan organized an extension activity. Students and instructors from the Textiles and Clothing Department show a surface decoration method on fabric in this demonstration. Village women and girls learned several embroidery techniques, including the satin stitch, the herringbone thread, the chain stitch, and Printing technique with stencil printing. This method is primarily used in both the design of fabrics and clothing. They can make income through the use of this surface decoration technique.
