Report of Textile and Clothing Department

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• One day educational trip to Ahmedabad was organized by textiles and clothing department on 20/02/2013. 30 college students and 17 students from P.G. department of Home Science, S.P. University visited two units. At Nirman textiles Pvt. Ltd , students were exposed to various processes of woven fabric manufacture and the finishing treatments imparted to them. At second unit i.e. Staple knit Ltd., students got practical knowledge of knitted fabric manufacturing on circular looms. Students later on visited the process house for dyeing of knits. This study tour was arranged by faculties Ms. Alpana Shah , Mr. Yogesh Vadwala, Ms. Daxa Sharma under guidance of Rekha Emanuel, the principal.





- On 26/2/2013 Farewell party and on 21/9/2013 Welcome Party was organized. 18 T.Y students and 12 S.Y students participated.
- Exhibition was held for two days on 27/9/2013 and 28/9/2013. Hand crafted Chaniya choli were displayed by two T.Y students for all college students under the guidance of faculty members Mrs. Alpana Shah and Mrs. Daxa Sharma.

During the visit students were exposed to traditional hand crafted textiles and woven shawls of Gujarat. At Bhujodi students gained information about shawls made up of various animal fibers, the process of shawl manufacture and typicality of Bhuj Shawls. On day second they visited tie and dye units at Bhujwhere they learnt the shibori and other tyeing and dyeing with reactive, acid and natural colors.
