She requested the team to present the report of NAAC 2019-20 visit. Ms. Sushma Batra & Dr. Nidhi Gupta presented the report. Criterion 2 (Teaching & Learning) got the highest score whereas, Criterion 5 (Student progression) got the lowest score among all the 7 criteria. As per the NAAC peer team there were some high & low performance indicators.

High Performance Key Indicators were:

- Physical facilities of the college

Low Performance Key indicators were:

- Library to be strengthened by latest edition of books and journals with extension of working hours.
- Students' participation in national and international events
- Financial resource mobilization through consultancies & other services to be promoted
- Alumni Association to be registered & strengthened
- College to introduce shift system as per the need of the students
- Effective Placement Cell required
- The Institute should provide financial assistance to faculty members for workshop/seminar/conference

Dr. Bhavana agreed with all the recommendations as they were all positive. She then introduced the new IQAC team.

Mrs. Rekha Emanuel suggested that though we are doing well, we need more marketing as this is an age of marketing. Dr. Bhavana mentioned that we do give press reports of every event of the college but in local newspaper, we need to go at national and international level too. She also talked about enewsletter that it is in the pipe line and soon we would publish our Biannual E- newsletter which may increase our horizon.
